Opportunities for ProCLAYM to gather and learn about new trends and idea that will inspire us to enrich parish programs as we minis-

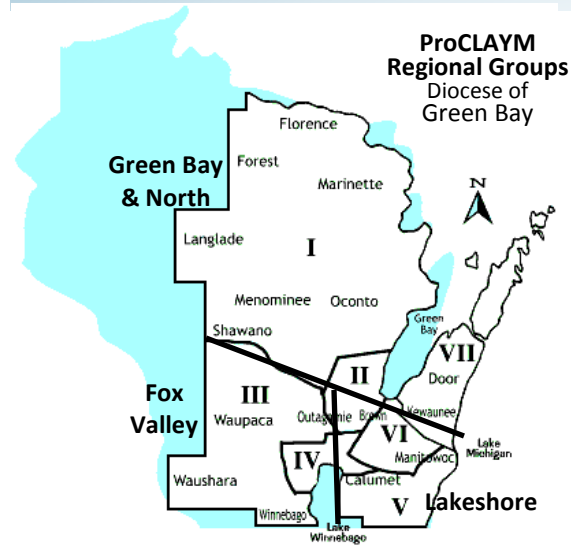


## Diocesan Sponsored Events
